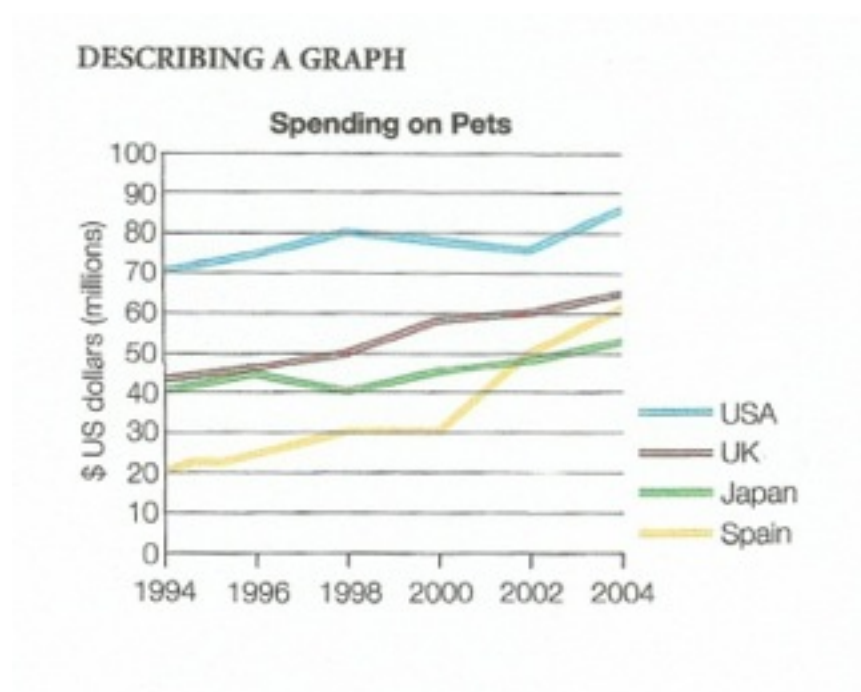

2. Complete the description of the graph below using the adjective/adverb given and a suitable comparison structure.



The graph shows the amount of money spent on pets in the UK, the USA., Japan and Spain between 1994 and 2004.

In 1994 Spain spent 1. \_\_\_\_\_ (little) amount of money on pets while Japan and the UK spent about 2. \_\_\_\_\_ (much) each other. However by 2000, the gap in spending between these two countries had widened and considerably 3. \_\_\_\_\_ (much) money was spent in the UK \_\_\_\_\_ in Japan.

The amount spent increased in all four countries but rose 4. \_\_\_\_\_ (dramatically) in Spain. In 2004 the Spanish spent 5. \_\_\_\_\_ (three times /much) money \_\_\_\_\_ they did in 1994.

However during this ten-year period the USA remained 6. \_\_\_\_\_ (big) spenders on pets, with all three other countries spending \_\_\_\_\_ little on them.
